

Privacy Policy

At Members First Credit Union, your privacy is a top priority. We protect the confidentiality and integrity of each member's nonpublic information.

We collect nonpublic personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications and other forms
- Information about your transactions with us and others
- Information we receive from consumer reporting agencies
- Information obtained when verifying the information you provide on an application or other forms, such as from your current or past employers or from other institutions where you conduct financial transactions
- Web site information

We do not disclose any nonpublic information about you to anyone, except as permitted or required by law.

If you decide to terminate your membership with Members First Credit Union or become an inactive member, we will not share information we have collected about you, except as may be permitted or required by law.

How We Protect Your Information

Members First Credit Union restricts access to your personal and account information to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with Federal regulations to guard your nonpublic personal information.
